Transfer Admission Standards

Applicants must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale. If you were not admissible to IUPUI as a freshman, 15 hours of transferable work (including college algebra and freshman composition) must also be completed prior to transfer. Schools and departments may set higher criteria for dual admission into their programs as well as University College; therefore, satisfaction of the minimum requirements does not guarantee admission into a particular IUPUI school or degree program. If you do not meet the requirements for your intended program but still meet the general admission standards of the campus, you will be admitted to IUPUI's University College where you will complete any prerequisites before applying to your intended program. Purdue University students with a cumulative grade point average below a 2.0 but not on "drop" status are considered on a case-by-case basis.

Assuming you were admissible as a freshman but your college GPA is below a 2.0 average or you have been dismissed from another college or university for the first time, you must sit out for one regular semester. Note: summer sessions are not considered regular semesters. All Purdue University students on "drop" status must sit out one regular semester. You may then be considered for conditional admission.

In addition, some programs require a petition if your GPA is below a 2.0. After you apply, we will advise you if that step is necessary. Since you do not know if a petition will be required, we recommend that you apply at least three months before you plan to start classes.

Transferring Credits

Only grades of C or better from regionally (or in some cases, nationally) accredited colleges and universities will transfer to IUPUI. (Students who complete courses at Purdue University campuses with grades of D will be granted transfer credit in some cases.)

Also, only coursework completed in academic disciplines which are available at IUPUI will be considered for transfer. There is no time limit for the acceptance of transfer credit; however, if the coursework is ten or more years old, the dates will be so noted, and you should discuss the courses with your advisor. Some programs have time limits for completion of specific courses. There are also limits to the amount of transfer credit that can be used to satisfy degree requirements. Graduate credit is not transferable to an undergraduate degree program unless approved by the dean in the school that will grant the degree.

The Office of Undergraduate Admissions is responsible for equating transfer coursework with IUPUI courses. Once the courses have been equated, it is the responsibility of the IUPUI program to determine how these credits will apply toward that school's degree. You and your advisor will review your credit evaluation when you attend New Student Orientation prior to enrollment.

Previous Attendance at IUPUI or Another Campus of IU

If you have attended another IU campus as a degree-seeking student, you are an intercampus transfer and you must apply online at enroll.iupui.edu. If you previously attended IUPUI and wish to return, see returnto.iupui.edu for the steps to follow. If you are not sure of your status, call the Admissions Center (317-274-4591).

Examination Programs

The Advanced Placement Program (AP), College-Level Examination Program (CLEP), international Baccalaureate Program, and DANES Credit-by-Examination Program provide students with the opportunity to earn transfer credit by completing examinations. IUPUI has its own policy regarding which exams are acceptable, the minimum scores required, and the amount of credit granted. Contact the Office of Undergraduate Admissions for a copy of the current IUPUI policy or visit enroll.iupui.edu.

Departmental Credit

If you received departmental credit either by placement or an examination at your former institution, you will receive transfer credit for that departmental exam or departmental credit, provided the credit has been validated by successfully completing the next higher course in the sequence. The next higher course must be completed at the same institution that granted original credit.

If you want to test out of IUPUI departmental credit, you should contact the department that offers the course. The department will outline its procedures for granting departmental credit. This may be done after you register for classes at IUPUI.

Admissions Timeline

Once your application is complete, a decision or a request for additional information will be sent to you. A complete application generally means the application itself, the application fee, and required high school transcript and/or college transcripts.

Checking Status of Your Application

If you provide us with your e-mail address when you apply, you will receive an e-mail with instructions on creating your account and checking the status of your application online. The e-mail will be sent after your application is initially loaded into our system.

Important Ethnic Information

Ethnic information is gathered in compliance with the definitions and procedures included in the 1997 revision of the OMB Statistical Policy Directive No. 15 and the U.S. Department of Education Final Guidance on Maintaining, Collecting, and Reporting Racial and Ethnic Data to the Department of Education (Federal

Register, Vol. 72, No. 202, 10/19/2008). This information will not be used in determining your admissibility to IUPUI.

IUPUI prohibits discrimination based on arbitrary consideration of such characteristics as age, color, disability, ethnicity, marital status, national origin, race, religion, sexual orientation, or veteran status.

Social Security Number

You will be assigned a ten-digit number that will be your University I.D. That number will be included with your admission correspondence. Your Social Security Number will not be used for this purpose.

Please note that *Section 483 and 484 of the Higher Education Act (HEA) of 1965, as amended, provide the Department of Education the authority to ask you and your parents the questions on the FAFSA and to collect the Social Security numbers of you and your parents. State and institutional student financial aid programs also may use the information that you provide on the FAFSA to determine if you are eligible to receive state and institutional aid.*

Application Fee

All students applying to IUPUI must pay the \$50 application fee (even if you have applied to another campus in the IU system) unless you fall into one of the following categories:

- If you applied to IUPUI and paid an application fee within the past 18 months.
- A Purdue student applying as a visiting or transfer student.
- An Ivy Tech Community College or Vincennes student who has either earned an Ivy Tech or Vincennes associate's degree or who has completed 45 hours of work and is enrolled at Ivy Tech or Vincennes at the time of application.

Students with Education Outside the United States

If you are a U.S. citizen or a non citizen with permanent resident, refugee, or asylee status and the last year of your education was in the United States, you should apply through the Office of Undergraduate Admissions. U. S. citizens who attend American Schools, International schools that hold U.S. accreditation, or Department of Defense Schools also apply through the Undergraduate Admissions Office. All other prospective students will apply through the Office of International Affairs. That office evaluates international educational documents and advises international students on visa matters and cultural adjustment issues. Criminal Activity Disclosure Policy

IUPUI is committed to maintaining a safe environment for all members of the University community. As part of this commitment, IUPUI requires applicants who have (1) been convicted

of any felony or a misdemeanor such as simple battery or other convictions for behavior that resulted in injury to a person(s) or personal property or (2) a history of formal disciplinary action at any college or university attended to disclose this information as a mandatory step in the application process. A previous conviction or previous college disciplinary action does not automatically bar admission to the University, but does require review.

Applicants are responsible for maintaining the receipt certifying that the letter has been received by IUPUI. **Information should be submitted in English and should include: a brief explanation, location (city, state, country) of conviction of previous conduct, dates and court disposition.** This statement must also include a grant of permission to IUPUI for complete access to criminal records, if any. Applicants who have been disciplined at another college or university must provide a statement, which includes a brief explanation, location and name of institution, dates, and disposition of the case. This statement must also include a grant of permission to IUPUI for complete access to disciplinary records, if any, at the previous college or university. Final Transcripts

If you are currently enrolled in college courses, you must arrange for a final transcript to be sent to the Office of Undergraduate Admissions. Please note that if your final cumulative GPA falls below a 2.0 or if you receive a grade below a C in the final semester, your offer of admission may be revoked.

Military Training

Military training will be evaluated for college credit. Please include a copy of your DD214 or DD295. You can receive up to eight semester hours of transfer credit for completion of basic training. Additional credits may be granted for specialized military training listed on these documents; however, the total credit will be limited to fifteen hours. Students who are admitted into Purdue programs will only receive a total of eight semester hours for all of their military experience.
