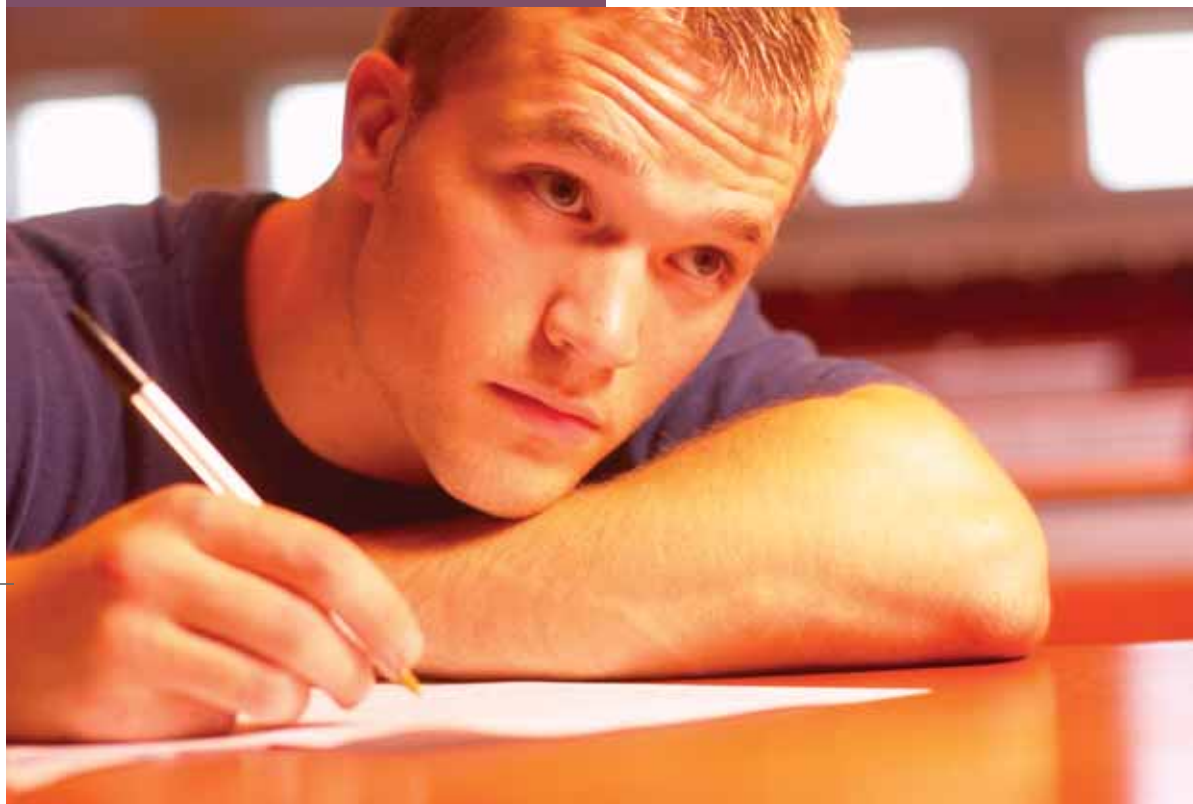


Credit By Examination 2008

IUPUI



IUPUI grants credit by examination for the following national examinations: Advanced Placement Exams (AP), International Baccalaureate exams (IB), College Level Examination Program (CLEP), and the Defense Activity for Non-Traditional Education Support Program (DANTES). There is no charge for posting these credits.

To receive credit official examination results must be sent directly from the appropriate testing agency.

International Baccalaureate Exam

Eight hours of appropriate credit is awarded for higher level exams with scores of 4 or higher.

DANTES and CLEP

The College Level Examination Program (CLEP) and the Defense Activity for Non-Traditional Education Support Program (DANTES) enable students to earn transfer credit for what they have learned on the job, through self-study or personal interest. If you have already completed college or university coursework in a particular academic discipline and now wish to test in that area, you may not be eligible to receive credit by examination. The Office of Admissions will pre-approve an exam

for IUPUI degree students who submit a Credit Transfer Agreement form. For a listing of courses, required scores, and IUPUI credit, consult <http://www.enroll.iupui.edu/creditbyexamination.shtml>. Advanced Placement Exams (AP)

The Advanced Placement (AP) program allows high school students to enroll in college level courses and test their proficiency by taking an exam. Students should request that their scores be sent to IUPUI. The Office of Admissions will post the transfer credit and then inform you how to access the posting on line.
